Pathways Extra Internship

Gain work experience before starting your degree

What is a Pathways Extra Internship?

The Pathways Extra Internship is an exciting chance for you to gain work experience after your pathway course and before you progress to university. Once you have completed your pathway course, you'll undertake the Pathways Extra Internship remotely from your home country for 8 weeks, and finish in time to start your degree.

Your placement is organised by Virtual Internships. With remote interns from 50+ countries, they have the expertise to pair you with an internship opportunity that suits you, from a choice of 18 career fields.

Features of your virtual internship include:

- 2 one-to-one coaching workshops with a specialist careers adviser
- 10–12 of hours coaching materials from award-winning online professional development hub CareerBridge
- working on your placement for 20–30 hours per week
- specialist support from Virtual Internships throughout your work placement
- peer support from students-taking an internship

The internship is available on most of our UK pathway courses at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.
