Examples of more advanced technical skills that a job might require include programming languages, technical writing, or data analysis.

What is Creative, Design, & Fashion career field?

Creative design involves using computer-generated imagery and digital animation to visualise a product. It aims to produce unique and memorable designs that stand out so that customers may easily identify a brand or product. Creative design had become increasingly important in the modern world, where each day numerous products are launched into the market.

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Possible Careers in Real Estate

Graphic designer

Graphic designers are visual communicators who create concepts by hand or by using specialized graphic design software. They communicate ideas to inspire, inform, or captivate consumers through both physical and virtual art forms that include images, words, or graphics. By constant communication with clients, customers, and other designers, they ensure that their designs accurately reflect the desired message and effectively express information.

Fashion designer

Fashion designers create women's, men's and children's apparel. This might include sportswear, maternity wear, outerwear, underwear, formalwear, eyewear, and footwear. There are also accessory designers who design belts, scarves, hats, handbags, and hosiery.

Fashion designers market their fashions through runway shows, as well as through their own retail stores. Some also lend their name to other licensed products in order to expand their brand identity. In fact, many celebrity fashion designers actually do very little designing of the collections that bear their name.

Industrial designer

Industrial designers imagine how consumers might use a product and test different designs with consumers to see how each design looks and works. They generally focus on a particular product category.

For example, some design medical equipment, while others work on consumer electronics products, such as computers or smart phones. Yet other designers develop ideas for new bicycles, furniture, housewares, or automobiles.

Copywriter

Copywriters, or Marketing Writers, are responsible for producing engaging, clear text for different advertising channels such as websites, print ads and catalogs. Their duties include researching keywords, producing interesting written content and proofreading their work for accuracy and quality.

- 13. What is your process for creating a new product design?
- 14. Provide an example of a product you would redesign if you could.
