The requirement for a visa when travelling to foreign countries should be removed for all nationalities.

e.g. visas are required

People need visas so foreign countries will let them in. Countries can decide who they want to let in and only give out visas to those people. This means they can stop loads of immigrants coming in, or stop terrorists.

Obviously though it's a bit of a pain to have to get a visa every time you want to go somewhere. So some people think we shouldn't have to use visas at all. But I reckon that's a stupid idea. Anyone can see that getting rid of visas wouldn't work, because countries need to be able to choose who gets in. They could make it a bit easier to get a visa though.

Visas are required in order to allow people access to a country. Countries can decide who they allow access to and provide visas only to those they consider suitable. This prevents excessive immigration and may reduce the potential threat of terrorism. However, many people argue that it is an inconvenience to apply for a visa each time you wish to travel and therefore advocate abolishing visas altogether. This essay will argue that visas are necessary in order to properly control borders and prevent security threats, although the process of acquiring a visa could be made easier.
